Perfect Waffle Stitch Washcloth Crochet Pattern!






CH = CHAIN

DC = DOUBLE CROCHET

SC = SINGLE CROCHET

ST = STITCH

FPDC = FRONT POST DOUBLE CROCHET;
YARN OVER, HOOK AROUND DC ST BELOW,
YARN OVER, PULL THROUGH LIKE A DC/
PULL THROUGH TWO, THEN TWO AGAIN



rows

I USED WEIGHT 3 GRAY LINEN YARN WITH A 4.25MM-G/6 HOOK

ROW 1: CH 29, ONE STITCH WILL NOT COUNT ROW 2: DC 3RD CH FROM THE LAST LOOP DC ACROSS ROW 2, 28 STITCHES



ROWS

ROW 3: CH 2 TURN, THIS COUNTS AS A DC, FPDC THROUGH NEXT DC BELOW FROM ROW 2, FPDC NEXT DC BELOW, THEN STARTS PATTERN. DC, FPDC 2, DC, CONTINUE UNTIL END OF ROW CH 2, TURN ROW 4: DC 2, FPDC, DC 2, FPDC, DC 2 UNTIL END OF ROW, CH 2, TURN REPEAT ROWS 3 AND 4 UNTIL YOU GET YOUR DESIRED LENGTH.



rows

YOU CAN END AFTER YOU GET YOUR DESIRED SIZE, OR CONTINUE BY ADDING A BORDER. I DECIDED TO ADD A BORDER OF SC

BORDER: CH 1 FROM END OF ROW, TURN AND SC INTO EVERY SPACE EVENLY AROUND THE WHOLE WASHCLOTH. TO MAKE A MORE DURABLE BORDER I DID THIS TWICE AROUND.
